The only residential substance use treatment program on Maui that serves pregnant and parenting women, where children can stay with their moms in treatment.

Therapeutic Living Program

This program provides a structured, supportive, sober living environment for women and their children. Services include stabilization, effective and evidence-based substance use treatment, individual and family counseling, skill-building classes, rehabilitative life skills classes, case management to help with re-entry into the community, and connections with other community resources.

Staff is present 24/7 to provide support. The Early Learning Center provides free childcare, referrals to prenatal care, and early childhood learning and development services and is located within the same facility.

Baby SAFE (Substance Abuse Free Environment)

BabySAFE is an outreach and early intervention program for women who are at-risk for tobacco, alcohol and/or substance use. The program offers treatment and intensive case management to pregnant women so they can achieve sobriety, have healthy pregnancies and give birth to thriving babies.

Sober Living Program

Those who have recently completed substance use treatment programs often need step-down services prior to re-entering the community in order to maintain sobriety. Most need to address medical, emotional, financial and employment challenges, and during this crucial time in their recovery, are at high risk for relapse. SLP provides a safe, affordable and substance-free living environment for women and children.

Here they solidify gains made in residential treatment and generate healthy and sober support in the community. Clients are required to have participated in a Malama Family Recovery Center program in the last six months, and are expected to be fully engaged in their health and wellness plans.
